The goals for this Bay Front replenishment project are as follows:

- stop the erosion
- save the tidal pond
- protect the houses bordering the pond
- develop a recreational area for swimming and fishing
- supply habitat for wildlife

The project, at the time of this writing, is about 20% completed.

As the project continues, updates will be provided at the monthly R.C.I.A. meetings.

Boat Ramp Key Distribution

Boat Ramp Keys will be distributed on March 29th and April 19th from 9:00 AM till Noon at Riviera Beach Community Park. Rain dates will be March 30th and April 20th.

You will need to bring your driver's license (proof of residency), completed Boat Ramp Key Application and application fee. Application forms can found below or on the web at www.riviera-beach-md.org.



Applications must be completed in its entirety including make and model of boat, registration information, tow vehicle information and tag number.

The cost of the key is \$40.00. If you bring last year's key, you will receive a rebate of \$5.00, making the cost \$35.00.

A copy of the boat ramp rules will be provided to each boat owner, and

you will need to sign that you have read the rules and will abide by them.

Only residents of Riviera Beach may use this ramp to launch their boats, and all vehicles parked at the ramp must display a current sticker.
