2006 RCIA DUES ARE NOW DUE

This year due to the increase in fuel costs, we must pay a 10% surcharge on our grass cutting contract. If more residents do not pay their annual \$25.00 dues, we will be forced to cut back on the grass cutting of community areas, this could include the **PARK**. It is **VITAL** that you send in your **DUES**.

Your dues pay for cutting the grass in the park and other community property, electric in the park and at the boat

ramp, maintenance of park equipment, community signs and this newsletter to mention a few.
