



From the President

As you may have heard or noticed, the Beach Front Project is currently under a stop work order. This was precipitated by resident complaints, inspections by Anne Arundel County and Maryland Department of the Environment.

Some items were identified that need to be corrected. Details are being worked on to get the Project back on track.

Anne Arundel County has stated that the 2007-2008 erosion budget for this project is valid with the exception of a bridge across the inlet to the tidal pond.

The cost for that bridge is approximately \$20,000.00. We will need to determine how to fund this bridge in the future.

Recent erosion fund projects that were successfully completed are:

- Waterfront restoration of Sledge's Point
- Surfside improvement project
- Carroll Road project

Your R. C. I. A. Board has worked diligently over the last few years to improve the quality of life in our community. We have had some great successes:

- beach, park and boat ramp clean-ups
- re-surface fishing pier
- monitor boat ramp area
- children's parties at Halloween, Christmas and Easter
- attained non-profit status

Riviera Beach Project	\$ 36,750.00	*
Miscellaneous Emergency Services	\$ 73,810.00	**
Administration Fee Anne Arundel County	\$ 2,000.00	
Total:	\$112,560.00	

- * 1. Repair or replace steps at Park Rd.
- 2. Create steps to beach on Stoney Creek.
- 3. Create signs for right-a-ways and beach areas.
- 4. Purchase poles and install signs for critical areas.
- 5. Replace right-a-way barriers with metal poles set in concrete.

** Since there is no specific erosion project projected at this time, we have been advised by Anne Arundel County to designate this money for miscellaneous emergency services. If there was a major storm between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009, this money can be used to repair the damage. If the money is not used for storm damage it will be carried over to the 2010 budget for project use.

NOTE: The Bay Front project was budgeted for the 2007-2008 budget at \$365,000.00. It is scheduled to be completed by June 30, 2008. Therefore, it did not carry forward to the 2008-2009 budget.
