### Lawsuit update

On Monday March 26th, the circuit court ruled in favor of RCIA's motion for accounting by Riverbea to the community for the use of community funds and other assets. The court denied RCIA's motion to remove Riverbea Directors and strike current Riverbea counsel. Ensuring Riverbea's accountability to Riviera Beach residents for funds derived from community assets is essential in ensuring our money is being put back into our community. Discovery in preparation for the upcoming trial to hear arguments for the amended complaint are well underway and nearing completion. It is expected the court will hear the case this summer. Almost all of the documents associated with the case are on the website and additional information will be posted to the website and Facebook page as it becomes available.

During a recent audit of erosion fund disbursements it was determined that a duplicate payment had been made to RCIA's previous lawyer. This resulted in a temporary hold by the county on distribution of funds to our current lawyer. The error has been corrected and the overages are in the process of being recovered.

### **Boat Ramp Keys**
